



JOINING STAREHE BOYS' CENTRE - GRADE 10 2027

Starehe Boys' Centre is a charitable institution for bright but poor boys, giving them a unique holistic education. Our mission is to provide care and education for boys in need and inspire them to transform into productive and exemplary members of society. Since its foundation in 1959 more than seventeen thousand boys have been raised at Starehe, becoming capable and caring members of society, enhancing their chances in life and ultimately the welfare of their families. Old Starehians continue to make a positive contribution all over the world as competent professionals, conscientious public servants and innovative entrepreneurs.

To be admitted at Starehe, a child must fulfil the following three requirements:

- 1. The candidate must **select Starehe as their 1st choice** in the appropriate category for the pathways and tracks that they propose to pursue. Only applicants that make Starehe their 1st Choice will be considered for admission. Starehe will be offering all three pathways:
 - a. **Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics (STEM) Pathway:** Pure Science Track (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and Applied Science Track (Computer Studies, Agriculture)*
 - b. **Social Sciences Pathway:** Humanities and Business Studies Track (History, Geography, CRE, IRE, Business Studies) and Languages Track (German, French, Arabic, Mandarin)*
 - c. **Performing Arts & Sports Science Pathway:** Performing Arts Track (Music & Dance, Theatre & Film) and Sports Science Track (Sports & Recreation)**
- 2. The candidate must also complete and return our Yellow Form (attached). The Yellow Form is available from the Centre **free of charge**. Applicants may also fill a copy of the form if unable to obtain an original. It is of vital importance that this form be fully and truthfully completed, with all the requisite documents attached. Candidates may also request the Yellow Form by calling us on 0777761213 - 7, eMailing us on info@stareheboyscentre.ac.ke, or sending an SMS/WhatsApp message to 0727531001.*
- 3. The candidate **must perform very well** in the Kenya Junior School Education Assessment to win admission. Entry into Starehe is very competitive and hence only the best-performing candidates are considered. Because we endeavour to admit boys from every part of the country each year, Starehe does not have a standard cut-off applicable to all candidates from all counties. Candidates seeking to join the Centre are encouraged to aim for the highest possible score achievable.*

Application Deadlines

*The **deadline** for the submission of the Yellow Form for Grade 10 Admission in 2027 is **30th July 2026**. We recommend that the completed form be hand-delivered to the Centre, or sent by a reliable courier service that provides proof of delivery/receipt.*

Fees at Starehe

At least 70% of the places at Starehe are reserved for children from poor backgrounds, while 30% are granted to fee-paying children. Starehe seeks full/partial sponsorship for the disadvantaged children - and is only able to keep them in school due to the generosity of persons and organisations of goodwill from across the world. Old Starehians, our alumni, are our largest single sponsor. The fee-paying boys are charged fees according to the means of their families, subject to an economic minimum. We ardently encourage candidates applying for a

*sponsored place at Starehe to also **apply for support from the various Foundations and Programmes that support poor children**, including the Constituency Development Fund, County Government Bursaries, Equity Wings to Fly, the KCB Foundation, Education for All Children, etc. **Admission to Starehe does not disqualify a child from receiving such support**. Where they are granted such support, it will fund their education at Starehe should they be admitted at the Centre.*
